NME Family Discount Details

In 2010, the National Marriage Encounter Board established the Family Scholarship to honor Fr. Gabriel Calvo, the founder of Marriage Encounter. In October 2011, the NME Board approved another family discount to encourage more family participation in conferences. In 2013, The Board combined the Scholarship and discount with the result that the NME Family Discount essentially pays the full cost for children attending a conference with their families and one-half for children with their grandparents.

Rebate Opportunity

As an incentive to encourage **new couples** to attend the conference (in addition to the \$100.00 first-timer discount), the conference committee offers a \$25.00 rebate (paid after the conference ends) to the couple who invited them. Remind them to fill out the “If new...” line. Include the names of the couples you invite under Special Needs or email their names to the registration couple if invited after you turn in your form.
